Agreement

1) <u>The Family</u>

I/We shall

- Encourage my child to do his/her best;
- See that my/our child attends School regularly on time, properly equipped and appropriately dressed;
- Contact the School to inform teachers of reasons for absence on every day of absence preferably before 9.30am;
- Let the School know about any concerns or problems which might affect my child's work or behaviour, including cyber bullying and exposure to inappropriate images;
- Support the School's policies and guidelines for behaviour;
- Support my child in homework and other opportunities for home learning including hearing my child read regularly and helping them with learning their spellings and times tables or number bonds as set by their class teacher;
- Attend Parents' Evening and discussions about my child's progress either in person or virtually;
- During the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic I will not send my child to school if either them or someone in the household develops a new continuous cough, high temperature or loss of smell. I will endeavour to ensure that the person who is displaying the symptoms seeks a test as soon as possible. Once test results are known I will notify the school as soon as possible. If the test is negative my child will return to school if they are well enough to do so. If it is positive they will stay at home for 10 days if it is them who has tested positive and 14 days if it is someone else who has tested positive in the household;
- Encourage our children to wash their hands regularly and to catch any sneezes and coughs in a tissue and bin this after use;
- Encourage our children to let someone know if they are not feeling well;
- Encourage our children to think about personal space and how we can play safely with our friends at school;
- Get to know about my child's life at the School.

2) <u>The School will</u>

- The School will provide a safe, caring and stimulating environment;
- Encourage children to achieve their potential through appropriate teaching, high expectation and praise;
- Give children a broad, balanced and relevant curriculum, including spiritual, moral and cultural development;
- Encourage children to respect themselves, other people, property and their environment;
- Develop a sense of personal responsibility and self-discipline based on the Federation's values
- Contact Parents if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment;
- Let Parents know about concerns or problems which affect their child's work or behaviour;
- Send home an Annual Report of Progress and Achievement;

- Arrange two Parents' Evenings, each academic year, during which progress will be discussed. This may be held virtually or in person;
- Inform parents of Covid-19 cases in their child's class.
- Implement the schools risk assessment and enhanced cleaning procedures so as to ensure that the school is as safe as possible during this time;
- Ensure that anyone who displays symptoms of Covid-19 is isolated away from other pupils as soon as symptoms are noticed and parents are asked to collect if it is a pupil or if a volunteer or staff member they are asked to go home;
- Ensure that no one with known Covid-19 symptoms enters the site unless they have sought a test and have a negative result;
- Keep Parents informed about School activities through regular letters home, newsletters, website and notices about special events.

3) <u>The Child</u>

- I will take good care of the equipment and the building;
- I will walk inside the building;
- I will have respect for the feelings of others;
- I will keep my hands and feet to myself;
- I will wash my hands regularly and when told to do so by school staff;
- I will catch my sneezes and coughs in a tissue and bin this straight away;
- I will try and think about my friend's personal space so that we are able to play safely together;
- I will try to make sure that I do not touch things at school that I have been asked not to touch;
- I will be helpful.

4) <u>Together we will</u>

- Support any special needs;
- Encourage the children to keep to the School's Rules;
- Support our children's learning to help them achieve their best.
- Work together to try and keep our children and the wider school community safe during the ongoing Covid-19 situation.
