It is safest to avoid all foods with a precautionary "may contain" nuts warning.

Despite having the word 'nut' in their name the following foods are not from the tree nut family so do not need to be avoided

- Chestnut- is an edible product of a group of trees in the beech family
- Coconut - the fruit (seed) of a coconut palm tree
- Water chestnut - aquatic vegetable
- Nutmeg - seed of the nutmeg tree
- Butternut Squash - technically a fruit
- Pine nut - the edible seeds of pine trees
