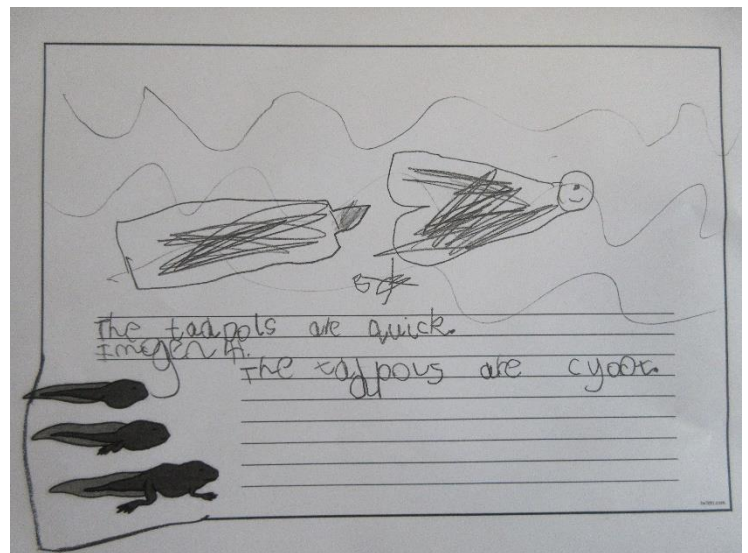
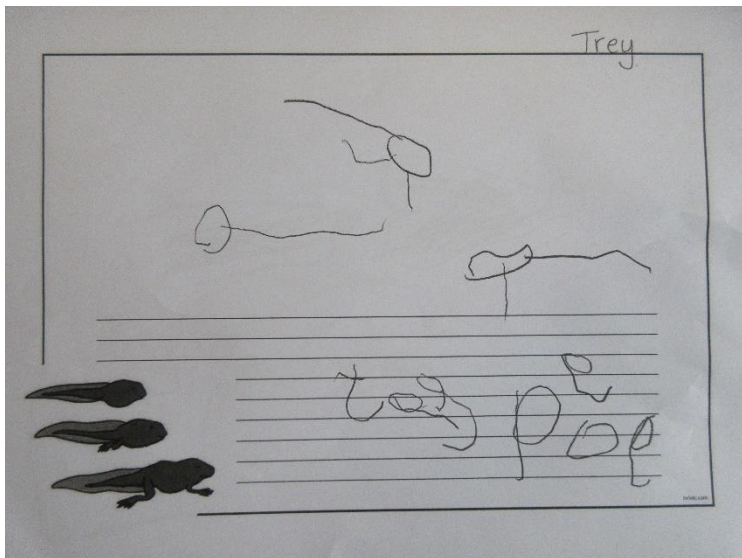
## Celebrating Pupil Success
