This is the joint birthdays of Lord and Lady Baden Powell, who started the Scouting and Guide Movements over 100 years ago.


Therefore, if any of our pupils are members of the Scouting and Guide movements and they would like to wear their uniforms at school on 22nd February they will be allowed to do so.
