Evacuation Procedures.

As well as regular fire evacuation practices schools should also do invacuation practices whereby we practice getting the school quickly inside. The reasons that we need to do this is so that all staff and children know what they need to if they have to come inside or close the doors to keep themselves safe. When these practices take place staff will always reassure children that it was a practice and will provide pupils with reminders about what they need to do. We are hopeful that by explaining to the children about the drill each time, they will have the same confidence as they do for our fire drills, and not come home feeling worried or anxious.
