Look out for the order forms coming home soon.

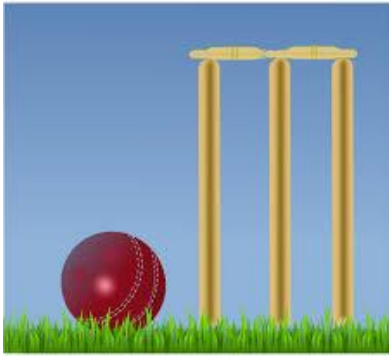
